



Field School Gear List

NOTE

You may ship your gear to Crow Canyon ahead of time. Please see "Getting You & Your Gear to Crow Canyon" for instructions.

Students should bring the following gear. There are laundry facilities on campus. Be sure to bring your own laundry detergent.

Pack wisely and be prepared! Choose gear for a variety of weather conditions. You will be in varying environments, ranging from 4,300 to 8,500 feet in elevation. Be prepared to dress in layers.

Clothing

- Hiking pants (lightweight, long pants are required for fieldwork)
- T-shirts (tank tops and halter tops are *not* recommended)
- Lightweight, long-sleeved shirts (these are cooler than short-sleeved shirts in the field)
- Socks and underwear
- Pajamas or other sleepwear
- Sweater or sweatshirt
- Windbreaker or jacket
- Wide-brimmed hat (a *must* for sun protection)
- Lightweight rain gear
- Comfortable walking shoes
- Hiking boots (a good pair is essential—over-the-ankle and broken in!)

Personal

- Sleeping bag/bedding
- Pillow
- Toiletries (soap, shampoo, toothpaste, etc.)
- Flip-flops or other footwear appropriate for use in the shower
- Towel and washcloth
- Personal medications (**These must be listed on the medical form and in their original containers**)
- Laundry detergent
- Cell phone and charger

Required Gear

- Notebook, pen and/or pencils
- One 1-quart water bottles (32 oz. total)
- Small daypack (large enough to hold water, jacket, rain gear, sunscreen, personal items)
- Sunscreen (SPF 15 or greater)
- Sunglasses

Suggested Items

- Flashlight
- Camera and accessories (film/memory cards/chargers/batteries/tripods, etc.)
- Insect repellent
- Personal travel coffee mug or drinking glass
- Swimsuit
- Hiking sandals
- Shorts
- Laptop or tablet
